### INVITATION

For the admission of 3 PhD candidates to the Doctoral Studies Program of the Department of Neurosurgery in the context of the International PhD program, during the winter semester of the academic year 2023-2024.

The Department of Neurosurgery announces 3 positions for PhD candidates for the winter semester of the academic year 2023-2024, according to the provisions of Law 4957/2022-Government Gazette 141/A/21-7-2022 and the general institutional framework as in force, articles 90-97 of the relevant regulations for doctoral studies, and the decision of the Assembly of the Faculty of Medicine as follows:

The right to apply for a doctoral dissertation is open to holders of a MSc or MA from domestic or recognized institutions (D.O.A.T.A.P., according to Law 3328 / A 80/2005) as equivalent foreign countries.

In special cases, a non- MSc or MA holder may be accepted as a doctoral candidate. These cases concern graduates of schools of over five (5) years of study and 300 ECTS and postgraduate students who have successfully completed the Postgraduate Studies Program, but the award of the degree is pending.

Candidates are invited to submit until 20/12/23 to the Department of Neurosurgery exclusively and only electronically at email: galexiou@uoi.gr, the following supporting documents:

- 1. Application
- 2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae
- 3. Certificate of adequate knowledge of English
- 4. Proposal for doctoral thesis (2.500 3.000 words)
- 5. Copy of undergraduate degree/s BSc
- 6. Copy of MSc/MA or certificate of completion of MSc/MA
- 7. Diploma supplement or equivalent
- 8. Copy of MSc thesis in digital form-with an extended English summary
- 9. Letters of recommendation (2)
- 10. Publications (if any)

The selection process will include an interview which will be done by teleconference.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of their performance in undergraduate studies, MSc or MA, the interview, the letters of recommendation they submit, the publications and their curriculum vitae.

The selection process will be completed by 15/04/2024
